

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE  
RESOLUTION NO. 2020-156**

- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws, Article IV Sections 1(k), and (m); and
- WHEREAS**, the Department of Health and Human Services, HHS-2018-ACF-ANA-NA-1339, Administration for Children and Families (ACF), the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) is accepting applications to grant for the FY 2021 community-based projects for the Native American Social and Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) - The purpose of the SEDS program is to promote social and economic self-sufficiency for American Indians, including social development that supports local access to, control of, and coordination with programs and services that safeguard the health, well-being, and culture of Native peoples.
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Child Care Program requests to submit an application for the Native American Social and Economic Development Strategies (CFDA# 93.612) grant program. The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Child Care Development program will provide project oversight and implementation; additionally community participation was integral in the planning of this project; and
- WHEREAS**, the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) requires a 20% match of the total proposed project. Contingent upon an ANA award level of \$400,000/year, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe agrees to the non-federal match requirement and hereby commits the use of Lakota Language Preservation funds in the amount of \$100,000/year in a combination of in-kind and cash match strategies as our commitment to the success of this vital program; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves and supports the submission of the ANA SEDS Grant Application by the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Child Care Services to the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families for a three-year project “to rebuild the Sicangu Lakota nation through our own language, ways of knowing, and ways of being by teaching children and families how to care for the earth like we were instructed and how to live with and on the earth in harmony with all other beings. “This project supports the Tribal goal of strengthening the Sicangu Lakota Oyate through focusing on the preservation and revitalization of the Lakota language, culture, and values.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribe commits to the 20% non-federal share to be allocated from the \$100,000 annual funding currently set-aside for the Rosebud Sioux
