

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE**  
**Resolution No. 2020-14**

- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to appropriate for public purposes of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe available Tribal Council funds pursuant to Article IV Sections 1 (g) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Rosebud Sioux Tribe Resolution 2018-293, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Maternal Child Health was granted authorization to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding and sub-award agreement with the Great Plains Tribal Chairmen's Health Board to implement project LAUNCH which is funded by the Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA); and
- WHEREAS,** the implementation of Project Launch consisted of a plan which sought to break down silos; create a coordinated care environment; improve continuity of care, strengthen communication and collaboration between agencies, service providers and families; build on current strengths to provide direct services that are evidence based, culturally appropriate and client centered; and
- WHEREAS,** one major deliverable of this agreement required by the Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) was to identify an evidence based home visiting model to be used with Project LAUNCH; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Maternal Child Health Program actively participated in the planning of Project LAUNCH and has been able to identify one evidence based home visiting model to implement on the Rosebud Reservation entitled "Family Spirit Home Visiting Model" which incorporates a holistic cultural approach to address pregnancy, parenting, health education, emotional and behavioral development and provides support for families; and
- WHEREAS,** the Family Spirit Home Visiting Model is owned by Johns Hopkins University/Bloomberg School of Public Health of Baltimore, Maryland and requires the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Maternal Child Health Program Director to enter into an agreement in the amount of \$30,305 for the provision of travel, training and development and any associated fees (see attached agreement and appendices); and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council has reviewed the agreement and authorizes the Director of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Maternal Child Health Program to enter into the \$30,305 Agreement with Johns Hopkins University for the purchase, training and implementation of the Family Spirit Home Visiting Model to be used with American Indians residing on the Rosebud reservation who utilize the services of the RST Maternal Child Health Program; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal President or the designated official to sign and execute all documents thereof.
