

ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
Resolution No. 2020-25

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is acting under the authority pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution and By-Laws; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has enacted Ordinance 80-03, as amended, to create the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's Judiciary Committee, to operate with participation from tribal membership and communities to develop and coordinate all aspects of law and order of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has enacted Ordinance No. 91-05, Rosebud Sioux Tribe Policy for Issuance of Tribal Commissions; and

WHEREAS, the RST Judiciary Committee recommends that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council amend RST Ordinance 91-05, Section 6, Classes of duty to include Corrections Officers, and Section 7, Authority, attached as Exhibit #1; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves the amendments to RST Ordinance 91-05, Section 6, Classes of tribal commissions to and Adult Corrections Officers, Section 7 to include authorization to use Electronic Control Devices (TASERS), to amend Section 7, Authority, Class A, and Class E, to authorize police officers and Fish and Game Wardens to carry Electronic Control Devices (TASERS), and to add Class F, Adult Corrections Officers, to define their duties and authorize carry, use and deployment of Electronic Control Devices, (TASERS), to amend Section 8, Training, to require Class A, E, and F, for the training and authorization in the use and deployment of Electronic Control Devices; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that forms for application an issuance of tribal commissions shall be revised to include "Corrections Officers," and authorization for the carry and use of "Electronic Control Devices," commonly known as "TASERS".


CERTIFICATION

POLICY FOR ISSURANCE OF TRIBAL COMMISION

The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Ordinance No. 91-05 Section 6 Classes, and Section 7, Authority, shall be amended, with the additional language, indicated as underlined text, and deleted language, indicated with a strike-through, as follows:

6. Classes: A tribal commission shall bear a picture of the carrier and shall identify the class of duty for which the commission is required. The class of duty shall be designated as one of these:

- a) Police Officer
- b) Security Guard
- c) Probation Officer
- d) Process Server
- e) Fish & Game Warden
- f) Adult Corrections Officer

7. AUTHORITY: Each classification of tribal commissions shall entitle the person commissioned shall entitle the person commissioned to use the following authority:

Class f. Adult Corrections Officer

- a. Authorized to take an adult into custody, and responsible for the care, custody and control of individuals who have been arrested and are awaiting trial or who have been convicted of a crime and sentenced to serve time in the RST Adult Correctional Facility or in the process of transfer or holding of adults to any other authorized detention facility. Also responsible for safety and security of the RST Adult Correctional Facility.
- b. Authorized to carry, use and deploy an Electronic Control Device, (Taser).

POLICY FOR ISSURANCE OF TRIBAL COMMISION

8. TRAINING. No person shall be issued a tribal commission a Class A or E, without first having satisfied the issuing authority that they have been fully trained to carry and use firearms and have been further trained in the enumerated police officers procedures, including the use, carry and deployment of Electronic Control Devices. (TASERS). No person shall be issued a Class F commission without satisfying the issuing authority that they have been fully trained in the deployment, use, and carry of Electronic Control Devices. (TASERS).

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
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
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
