

ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
Resolution No. 2020-197

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof: and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws Article IV Sections 1(k), and (m); and

WHEREAS, Bank of the West, Valentine, Nebraska, has requested a letter from the Rosebud Sioux Tribe stating that REDCO, Inc., is in good standing with the Tribe, verifying that REDCO Inc., has complied with all outstanding legal and other explicit obligations, while not being subject to any form of sanction, suspension, or disciplinary censure; and


BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council finds that REDCO, Inc., is in good standing has filed and continued to file all appropriate paperwork with the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, the RST Department Revenue, and any other applicable Tribal government agency, department and commission monitoring compliance with Rosebud Sioux Tribal law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe or his authorized delegate is authorized and directed to sign a Certificate of Good Standing with the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, and any other Tribal agency, department, and commission, on behalf of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, and to provide such certification to Bank of the West, Valentine, Nebraska.


CERTIFICATION
