Resolution No. 2020-95

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws article IV Section 1(k) and (m); and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has budgeted \$500,000 to the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) for the cooling season commencing April 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Summer Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is seeking authorization to assist Non-working elder's and zero income households with the following:

\$150 for zero income and non- working elder's with and income of \$1 to \$10,000.

\$125 for non-working elder household with and income of \$10,001 to \$20,000

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council adopts the recommendation of the RST LIHEAP cooling season and approves the request to assist zero income households and non-working elder households with zero income up to \$20,000 for the months of April 2020 to September 30, 2020.


CERTIFICATION

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

Amended: 04-22-20

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by the Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is the grantee of the Sicangu Lakota Oyate Head Start program; and

WHEREAS, the Sicangu Lakota Oyate Head Start program is requesting approval for the 2019-2020 Head Start Carry Over balance in the amount of \$674,224.14 before Head Starts fiscal year ends on March 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the SLO Head Start Grant Carry Over balance is from personnel, fringe, consultants, out of state travel, local mileage, building repair and maintenance and construction of the new Parmelee Head Start building which includes landscaping and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Carry Over balance will remain in these specific line items after Tribal Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Award letter received for the \$2.1 million Head Start Duration grant was not received until July 2019; four months after our fiscal started on April 1, 2019. The NOA required tribal council approval prior to spending, in addition to advertising and interviewing for twenty new positions and completing RFP's for equipment; and

WHEREAS, this resolution has been recommended for approval to the RST Tribal Council as Emergency Legislation for the amended amount from previous approval of \$674,224.14 to \$769,170.00; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves of the Sicangu Lakota Oyate Head Start/Early Head Start Carry Over budget amount of \$769,170.00.

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
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

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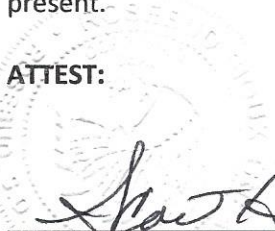
