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MOBILE MEDICAL UNITS

SUMMARY JUSTIFICATION

The RST COVID-19 Task Force had a discussion on June 29, 2020. A recommendation was made to the Tribal Administration to purchase two (2) mobile medical units. These units will be used for direct application within the Tribal communities. In the event that an outbreak may occur, the MMU's can be deployed as part of an initial response and used as an incident command center and as an center-of-operations location that is easily identifiable. It will carry the initial equipment and supplies that are necessary for the initial response and also be used for long-duration deployment.

A mobile medical unit will offer capabilities that play an important role in our limited healthcare system on the Reservation. An MMU will provide access to healthcare especially for displaced or isolated individuals; they offer versatility in the event of an over-stressed emergency or urgent-care department; and for walk-up/drive-up community-based service delivery by reaching our underserved communities in distant rural areas.

Due to the vast area that our Reservation encompasses, the Task Force has deemed it necessary to utilize two (2) MMU's to have effective and versatile coverage. With this in mind, we would have four facilities that could assess and treat any individuals during the pandemic. The first would be the highest level of care provided at and through the Indian Health Service-Rosebud Emergency Department. Secondly, a higher level of care will be provided at the Horizon Healthcare-Mission Medical Clinic. As the third and fourth facilities, the MMU's would provide an initial response capability to lessen the stress placed on these facilities by providing, at a minimum, the assessment prior to transportation to the hospital or clinic. Individuals could possibly be assessed and treated at the MMU and return home for their CHR or PHN monitored care or self-monitored care. This would be very beneficial to those who lack transportation or otherwise may not seek healthcare at the hospital or clinic. If you allow yourself, you can imagine other similar applications and opportunities for use throughout the lifetime of the pandemic, such as; continued wellness check-ups, vaccinations, and other more routine types of program services that have mostly been suspended during the pandemic.

This request is as a sole-source and indicated on the attached resolution. There are several mobile medical vehicles dealers/manufacturers in the United States, but their new, on-the-lot and ready-for-sale inventory, is becoming more scarce as time passes. When conducting comparisons with the inventories of the dealers, it became evident that the selected dealer offered the best price-for-options that could be found. Other used or refurbished units were considered prior to making this selection.

The MMU's will be parked at a location with security personnel to be provided during off-hours.







MOBILE MEDICAL UNITS

SUMMARY JUSTIFICATION

The RST COVID-19 Task Force had a discussion on June 29, 2020. A recommendation was made to the Tribal Administration to purchase two (2) mobile medical units. These units will be used for direct application within the Tribal communities. In the event that an outbreak may occur, the MMU's can be deployed as part of an initial response and used as an incident command center and as an center-of-operations location that is easily identifiable. It will carry the initial equipment and supplies that are necessary for the initial response and also be used for long-duration deployment.

A mobile medical unit will offer capabilities that play an important role in our limited healthcare system on the Reservation. An MMU will provide access to healthcare especially for displaced or isolated individuals; they offer versatility in the event of an over-stressed emergency or urgent-care department; and for walk-up/drive-up community-based service delivery by reaching our underserved communities in distant rural areas.

Due to the vast area that our Reservation encompasses, the Task Force has deemed it necessary to utilize two (2) MMU's to have effective and versatile coverage. With this in mind, we would have four facilities that could assess and treat any individuals during the pandemic. The first would be the highest level of care provided at and through the Indian Health Service-Rosebud Emergency Department. Secondly, a higher level of care will be provided at the Horizon Healthcare-Mission Medical Clinic. As the third and fourth facilities, the MMU's would provide an initial response capability to lessen the stress placed on these facilities by providing, at a minimum, the assessment prior to transportation to the hospital or clinic. Individuals could possibly be assessed and treated at the MMU and return home for their CHR or PHN monitored care or self-monitored care. This would be very beneficial to those who lack transportation or otherwise may not seek healthcare at the hospital or clinic. If you allow yourself, you can imagine other similar applications and opportunities for use throughout the lifetime of the pandemic, such as; continued wellness check-ups, vaccinations, and other more routine types of program services that have mostly been suspended during the pandemic.

This request is as a sole-source and indicated on the attached resolution. There are several mobile medical vehicles dealers/manufacturers in the United States, but their new, on-the-lot and ready-for-sale inventory, is becoming more scarce as time passes. When conducting comparisons with the inventories of the dealers, it became evident that the selected dealer offered the best price-for-options that could be found. Other used or refurbished units were considered prior to making this selection.

The MMU's will be parked at a location with security personnel to be provided during off-hours.





In any suit instituted against Customer on this Agreement, Customer agrees to abide by the final decision of the court or of any appellate court in the event of an appeal. 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
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

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
