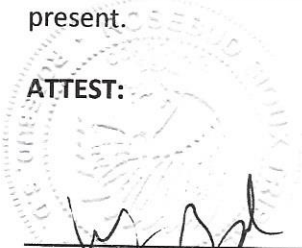
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and
- WHEREAS**, the Constitution and By-laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Article IV Section 1 (a) authorizes the Tribal Council to negotiate with the Federal, State and local governments on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS**, the State of South Dakota Division of Social Services Division of Behavioral Health has established standards for state Intensive Methamphetamine Treatment Expansion Programs to support treatment services for adults who are assessed with a severe methamphetamine use disorder, who require 24-hour structure and support due to the imminent risk for relapse. Clients require long-term treatment to allow for recovery of cognitive capacity as well as on-going case management, the length of service in any level of care shall be determined based upon the individualized needs presented by each client; and
- WHEREAS**, the Contract for Intensive Methamphetamine Treatment Expansion Program (the "Agreement"), effective from June 1, 2020, and shall end on May 31, 2021, in the amount" up to \$581,080.00, describes expectations and requirements of contracted agencies for the intensive methamphetamine expansion programs and rates for services; and
- WHEREAS**, the Agreement provision, Controlling Law, provides the Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of South Dakota, without regard to any conflicts of law principles, decisional law, or statutory provisions which would require or permit the application of another jurisdiction's substantive law. Venue for any lawsuit pertaining to or affecting this Agreement shall be in the United States District Court, District of South Dakota; and
- WHEREAS**, Federal law provides that a Tribe must unequivocally and clearly express any waiver of the sovereign immunity in writing; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council hereby agrees with the terms and provisions of the Agreement for Intensive Methamphetamine Treatment; and
- BE IT ALSO RESOLVED**, That the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe or his authorized delegate is authorized and directed to sign and execute the Agreement for Intensive Methamphetamine Treatment on behalf of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe.
