

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE**  
**Resolution No. 2020-29**

**WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

**WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and

**WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws, Article IV Sections 1(k), and (m); and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Governmental Affairs Committee has the authority and responsibility to review and recommend to Tribal Council approval of plans and projects initiated for the benefit of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** The United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office for Victims of Crime has awarded for the FY 2019 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program CFDA # 16.841 \$720,000 for thirty-six (36) months to implement the Elder Justice Initiative, in which the Elderly Nutrition Program will take the lead in, and provide for policies to support the work of protection our elders from physical, emotional and financial abuse; and

**WHEREAS,** The overall goal of the RST Elder Justice Initiative is to provide support to tribal communities to improve services for elder victims of crime and will support a comprehensive range of activities to address the needs of a wide variety of Elderly crime victims in tribal communities; and

**WHEREAS,** The Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) require comprehensive confidentiality polices, and the Elderly Nutrition Program has endorsed these policies, based in OVC's requirements and seeks the approval of an appropriate committee to accept them as part of the programs policies; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves and adopts the recommendation of the Governmental Affairs Committee and accepts these internal confidentiality polices for Elderly Nutrition Program for serving the needs of our Elders.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal President or the designated official to sign and execute all applications and all documents thereof.

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
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
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**CERTIFICATION**
