- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof: and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Article IV, Section 1 (c), authorizes the Tribal Council to purchase and to otherwise acquire lands and other property for or on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is authorized to appropriate for public purposes of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe available Tribal Council funds pursuant to Article TV Section 1 (g) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Article IV, Section 1 (u) authorizes the Tribal Council to delegate to subordinate boards or tribal officials any of the foregoing powers, reserving the right to review any action taken by virtue of such delegated power; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe has authorized a subordinate organization under the Tribal Council known as Tribal Land Enterprise ("TLE"), for the overall management of land and interests in tribal and allotted lands; and
- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has passed RST Resolution No. 2015-20, amended on April 14, 2018, authorizing TLE to drawdown funds from the Office of Special Trustee, Proceeds of Labor Account No. PL-7394700 (RST Grazing Fees aka RST General Account) on a monthly basis, and to authorize two (2) members of the Tribal Land Enterprise Board of Directors signature authority on all financial transactions and withdraws as required by 25 CFR Part 115.815;
- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Treasurer recommends that the RST Tribal Council rescind RST Resolution No. 2015-20 as amended, to remove restrictions RST Resolution No. 2015-20, as amended, place on the Tribe's access to its own funds; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council adopts the recommendation of the RST Treasurer and rescinds RST Resolution No. 2015-20, as amended; and

- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof: and
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**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council adopts the recommendation of the RST Treasurer and rescinds RST Resolution No. 2015-20, as amended; and
