- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to appropriate for public purposes of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Available Tribal Council funds pursuant to Article IV, Sections 1 (g) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the RST Ordinance No. 88-12 is to implement Article IV of the Constitution and the By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe to appropriate and publish the efficient allocation of resources to meet tribal needs and provide public services; and
- WHEREAS, RST Ordinance No. 94-125 established a Rosebud Sioux Tribe Procurement Policies and Procedures for the acquisition of goods and services by departments and programs of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, RST Procurement Policies and Procedures requires a bidding process and approval by the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council for the acquisition of goods and services in the amount of \$10,000 and over; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council enacted RST Resolution No. 2020-75, to acknowledge and affirm the Rosebud Sioux Tribe President's declaration of a State of Emergency exists within the Rosebud Sioux Tribe as it relates to the threat to the health and public safety of the Rosebud Sioux Reservation from the spread of the novel Coronavirus (COVID 19), a global pandemic was declared by the World Health Organization (WHO) on March 11, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council has approved the purchase of twenty-two mobile home units to be placed within the Tribal Communities of the Rosebud Indian Reservation for quarantine and isolation of Tribal members during the pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, in an effort to provide the necessary and essential public health and safety services required to address the current State of Emergency as it relates to the spread of the Coronavirus, by providing a desirous and satisfactory water supply to serve the twenty-two mobile home, the RST CARES Office is requesting authorization from the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council to enter into a memorandum of agreement between the Rosebud Sioux Tribe CARES Act Office and the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Sewer Revenue Construction Program in the amount of \$267,710.00 to install and connect water delivery and sewer systems to serve the twenty-two mobile home units with completion by December 30, 2020; and

for quarantine and isolation of Tribal members during the pandemic; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe or his designee is authorized and directed to sign and execute all documents to install and connect water delivery and sewer systems to serve the twenty-two mobile home units.
