- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe has enacted the Game, Fish and Parks Code, Title V, Chapter 35, Rosebud Sioux Tribe Law and Order Code, to provide for an orderly system on the Rosebud Indian Reservation for the management and control of the wildlife, fishery, forestry and outdoor recreation resources of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the RST Department of Natural Resources/Game, Fish & Parks (DNRGFP) manages, administers and controls all matters relating to the propagation, conservation, management, distribution, transportation, storage and taking of fish and game and enforces the criminal and civil provisions of the RST Law and Order Code, subject to legislative oversight and supervision of the RST Land and Natural Resources Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the RSTDNRGFP recommends to the Land and Natural Resources Committee (LNRC) to approve the 2020 hunting seasons, number of tags issued and fees for Tribal members (TMs), affiliated Tribal members (ATMs) and non-Rosebud Sioux Tribal members (NMs) (see attached schedule); and
- WHEREAS, the Department has recommended the continued use of a drawing process for all 2020 big game licenses (excluding spring turkey); and
- WHEREAS, the RSTL&NRC has recommended that the NM trophy and archery elk bids be processed through a sealed bid process with 100% payment required at time of bid placement (no personal checks/no cash); and
- WHEREAS, the RSTL&NRC also discussed the attached Fall Hunting Schedule at a L&NRC meeting on March 2, 2020 and recommended this resolution, with the attached Fall Hunting Schedule, on to RSTC for approval: now
