

ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
Resolution No. 2020-34

- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to appropriate for public purposes of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe available Tribal Council funds pursuant to Article IV, Sections 1 (g) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Regional Division of Facilities would like to consult with the Rosebud Sioux Tribe regarding the proposed design of the St. Francis Indian School New Athletic Complex; and
- WHEREAS**, the Project consists of at a minimum of Architectural and Engineering design services for the replacement of the current athletic complex to include track and field events, grandstands (including press box), irrigation & regrading of the football field new score boards, new or upgraded field lighting, new concession stand (including storage and restrooms) and security fencing around the proposed complex; and
- WHEREAS**, the in accordance with the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs' commitment to support of Tribal Self-Governance and Self-Determination, they are soliciting input from the Rosebud Sioux Tribe regarding the appropriate method for completing the design of this potential project subject to the availability of funding. The execution of the design may be implemented using one of the following options:

Option Number one (1): P.L. 100-297 Grant-The Tribe or tribally-controlled school board (Grantee) elects to perform this project via a P.L. 100-297 grant. Grantees will be responsible for overall project management, status reporting and review coordination with Great Plains Regional Division of Facilities (GPR-DF) and completing all procurement actions, including the scope of work, in accordance with applicable federal, state and local building codes and standards, as well as additional requirements identified by GPR-DF.

Division of Facilities Management & Construction (DFMC-Albuquerque) will conduct an Organizational Capacity Review (OCR) to determine the Grantee's management capabilities in accordance with 25 U.S.C. 2503(b) (4) (iii). Upon completion of the OCR, a final decision awarding the grant will be made.

Option Number two (2): P.L. 93-638 Contract – The Tribe or tribal organization (Contractor) elects to perform the project via a P.L. 93-638 contract.

The Contractor will be responsible for the overall project management, status reporting, review coordination with the GPR-DF, and completing all procurement actions, including the scope of work, in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local building codes and standards, as well as additional requirements identified by GPR-DF.

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Option Number three (3); GPR-DF Performs the activities – The GPR-DF will be responsible for overall project management in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local building codes and standards.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Assistant Secretary –Indian Affairs’ commitment to support Tribal Self-Governance and Self-Determination, we are soliciting the input of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe on the appropriate method of completing the potential project subject to the availability of funding; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council selects Option Two (2) to Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs-Great Plains Region Division of Facilities (GPR-DF); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal President or the designated official to sign and execute all documents thereof.
