WHEREAS, the continuing lack of maintenance is threat to health and public safety of the residents of He Dog Community, Upper Cut Meat Community, and any other members and residents of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Rosebud Sioux Tribe contact the US Department of Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs to take immediate action that addresses the continued lack of maintenance and danger to the health and safety of the general public who use the old He Dog road on a regular basis; and

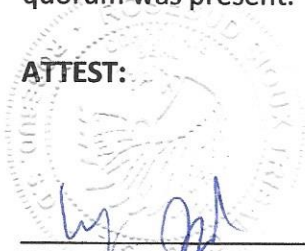
