

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE**  
**Resolution No. 2020-168**

**WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by the Tribal Council made up of elected Representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By Laws; and has under the appropriate authorities adopted ordinances for the promotion and regulation of utilities and telecommunication services within the jurisdiction of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is accepting applications in the 2.5 Ghz Rural Tribal Priority Window. This solicitation conveys an opportunity to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe to apply for unassigned allowable 2.5 Ghz frequencies on eligible rural Rosebud Sioux Tribal lands to help address the local digital divide; and

**WHEREAS**, most importantly, acquisition and implementation of the 2.5 Ghz spectrum on the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Reservation offers the Rosebud Sioux Tribe an opportunity to provide broadband wireless service and advance Reservation development.; now


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council officially approves of the development and submission of an application to the FCC for approval to allow the Rosebud Sioux Tribe to provide sufficient bandwidth and unassigned allowable 2.5Ghz spectrum over eligible Tribal lands to help address the communication needs of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Reservation.; now


**BE IT FURTHER**, that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to take any and all actions, including the execution of documents, papers, and other instruments, necessary to implement this resolution.
