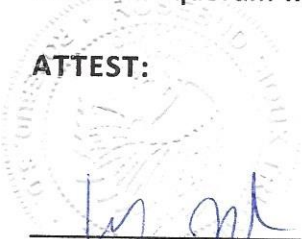
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and by-laws; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws, Article IV Sections 1 (k) and (m); and
- WHEREAS,** the RST Transportation Program receives funding from the Federal Transportation Administration through the SD Dept. of Transportation; and
- WHEREAS,** the RST Transportation Program is requesting that various federal assets be transferred directly to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe (see attached letter); and
- WHEREAS,** the RST is aware of assets having to contain a federal interest and knowingly and fully accept the all the conditions, limitations and responsibilities that apply when receiving the assets with federal interest; and
- WHEREAS,** the RST Transportation Program will also no longer have sub-recipient monitoring, oversight, or administration by the SODOT but may continue to apply for State managed FTA-funding; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Rosebud Sioux Tribe approves of the SD Department of Transportation to transfer the current assets (attached letter) to the RST Transportation Program and that the SDDOT will no longer have subrecipient monitoring, oversight or administration over the RST Transportation Program. Also the RST accepts all conditions, limitations, and responsibility when receiving federal assets.


