Resolution No. 2020-139

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 25 CFR 900.12, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe will submit the Annual Funding Agreement for the following PL 93-638 Indian Self-Determination Contracts and Grant for Fiscal Year 2021; and

WHEREAS, the PL 93-638, Indian Self-Determination Contracts are identified as the;

1. Consolidated Tribal Government Program (CTGP)
 - Enrollment
 - Forestry
 - Indian Child Welfare Act
 - Natural Resources
 - Sicangu Resource Development
 - Tribal Historic Preservation Office
 - Office of Management and Development
 - Truancy
 - Water Resources
2. RST-Law Enforcement Services
3. RST-Adult Corrections and Operations & Maintenance
4. Wambli Wiconi Tipi- Juvenile Detention Center and Operations & Maintenance
5. RST-Tribal Court Services
6. RST-Housing Improvement Program
7. RST-Road Maintenance
8. RST-Safety of Dams
9. Child Welfare-including Spotted Tail Children's Home
10. Contract Support Costs & Direct Contract Support Costs

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2021 funding is to be negotiated between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe will be operating with Fiscal Year 2020 carry over funding on a Continuing Resolution in Fiscal Year 2021 for all P.L. 93-638 Indian Self Determination Contracts until the Fiscal Year 2021 is negotiated and finalized; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Sicangu Resource Development is submitting the FY 2021 Annual Funding Agreement budgets to the BIA on behalf of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and


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

CERTIFICATION


