### **Summary**

The Task Force firmly believes with the cleaning kits that it is keeping the positive cases down within the Rosebud Sioux Tribe tribal members by providing these cleaning kits. It took RF Buche to use extreme measures to get the tribe these supplies with his influence and to support our tribe for the health and safety of our people.**
