- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Article IV Section 1 (a) authorizes the Tribal Council to negotiate with the Federal, State and local governments on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, The South Dakota School of Mines and Technology has requested the support and concurrence of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe for seeking a possible USDA Rural Development Grant for a New Tribal Administration Building for preliminary architectural/engineering design in an amount of \$250,000.00 due on April 30, 2020 to be administered by the University; and
- WHEREAS, A new administration building would support the Tribe in improved operational efficiency in delivery of government] services to Tribal members, and also provide for a better, safe and suitable work space for Tribal employees; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe to approve and authorize the support and concurrence of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe for seeking a possible USDA Rural Development Grant for a New Tribal Administration Building for preliminary architectural/engineering design in an amount of \$250,000.00 due on April 30, 2020 to be administered by the South Dakota School of Mines; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is authorized and directed to sign and execute a letter of support and any other necessary documents to apply for a USDA Rural Development Grant for the construction of a new Tribal Administration Building.
