# Comprehensive Older Adult Care

## **Age and Age-Related Health Outcomes**

### *Chronic Disease Burden & Managing Multiple Comorbidities*

- Data driven case management
- Population stratification and targeted interventions

### *Psycho-Social Impact of Ageing*

- Managing cognitive decline
- Addressing loneliness and isolation
- Facilitating social groups

### *Ageing in Place*

- Housing and home modification
- Palliative care programs

## **Economic Impact of a Growing Older Adult Population**

### *Value and Cost of Care*

- Elder care will continue to be a growing sector of overall healthcare costs
- Focusing on value of care and not cost containment can help build a sustainable business model

### *Decision-Making Framework*

- Ensuring patient autonomy and decisional capacity are prioritized
- Dealing with reduced cognitive ability – both at the individual and population level
- How to improve the responsiveness to emergent needs of the health system

## **Models of Elder Care**

### *Clinical & Long-Term Care*

- Strategies for institutional, non-institutional, and transitioning population
- How to ensure patient and family centered care

### *Funding*

- Medicare/Medicaid billing – if the tribe is able to offer all key health and social services to the elder population, even through different programs, they could qualify as a PACE program to receive capitation payments for all enrollees
- VA billing – IHS and the VA are currently revising their MOU, which may have a significant impact on billing and payment procedures
- Tribal budget and future 638 contracts

### *Cultural Orientation*

- Rooting the model of care in Lakota principles and values
- Increasing access to traditional Lakota health services
