- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, Article IV, Section 1(t), authorizes the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Council itself and of other tribal agencies and tribal officials; and
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- WHEREAS, The United States Congress has enacted the Coronovirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") Title V fund, and has published guidance and rules for the allocation and distribution of federal relief funds to tribal governments; and
- WHEREAS, In order to conduct oversight and to ensure compliance with federal law and regulations governing the use of federal relief funds and reporting standards, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council has passed a motion on June 2, 2020, to establish an ad hoc committee; and
- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe adopts and approves the creation, establishment and appointment of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Coronovirus COVID-19 Federal Relief Funds Oversight Committee, for the limited purpose of creating a budget, developing staff job descriptions for administration of Federal Cares Act Coronovirus COVID-19 relief funds, approve, review and recommendation of expenditures consistent with applicable federal law and regulations, committee appointment terms will continue until such time as the State of Emergency is declared abated, and/or exhaustion of federal relief funds; and
- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Coronovirus COVID-19 Federal Relief Funds Oversight Committee will consist of the Budget and Finance Committee Chair, Vice Chair and 2 members of the Budget and Finance Committee, which will meet as deemed necessary and at any such time in an emergency, remotely or in person, all actions will be recorded; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Coronovirus COVID-19 Federal Relief Funds Oversight Committee be established and terms shall be until such time as the State of Emergency is declared abated, and/or exhaustion of federal relief funds.
