




- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe has been awarded the FY-2019 Garrett Lee Smith State/Tribal Suicide Prevention Grant, Grant #1 H79 SM082 138-01 from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) at the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in the amount of \$3.7 million over five years; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Wiconi Wakan Program, funded by the RST SAMHSA Garrett Lee Smith Suicide Prevention Grant program will provide outreach, screening, and direct behavioral health services to RST members over a five (5) year project period; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe will establish an Advisory Committee to provide oversight and input to all grant-related activities, meeting regularly to ensure that grant activities, hiring decisions, reporting deadlines, and other aspects of the project are conducted to the highest standards; and
- WHEREAS**, representatives of the Advisory Committee shall include the following programs/ individuals or a designee: RST president, RST Health Administrator, RST Drug and Alcohol Treatment Program, Tribal Veterans Program, Law Enforcement, Sinte Gleska University, Rosebud I.H.S., Behavioral Health, St. Francis Mission Suicide & Crisis Hotline Coordinator, Spiritual Advisor, Massachusetts General Hospital Technical Assistance, Grant Evaluation Team Support, and two (2) national experts in behavioral health treatment, ideally in native communities; now
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council authorizes the establishment of the Advisory Committee for the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Wiconi Wakan SAMHSA Garrett Lee Smith Suicide Prevention Grant for the purpose of oversight and compliance.






