
- WHEREAS,** The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof: and
- WHEREAS,** The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and
- WHEREAS,** The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws Article IV Sections1 (k), and (m), and
- WHEREAS,** The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is authorized by Constitution and By-laws Article IV, Section 1 (g), to appropriate for public purposes of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe available tribal council funds; and
- WHEREAS,** RST Ordinance No. 94-125 established a Rosebud Sioux Tribe Procurement Policies and Procedures for the acquisition of goods and services by departments and programs of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** RST Procurement Policies and Procedures requires a bidding process and approval by the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council for the acquisition of goods and services in the amount of \$10,000.00 and over; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council has enacted RST Resolution No. 2020-75, to acknowledge and affirm the Rosebud Sioux Tribe President's declaration of a State of Emergency exists within the Rosebud Sioux Tribe as it relates to the threat to the health and public safety of the Rosebud Sioux Reservation from the spread of novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), a global pandemic declared by the World Health Organization ("WHO") on March 11, 2020; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Solid Waste Program provides sanitation services for Tribal members and has discovered an increase of approximately 200% of the amount of waste being generated during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic; and
- WHEREAS,** the increase in the amount of waste being generated in the communities is due to employees of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe having been placed on administrative leave status and generating more refuse at home, and the sporadic lock-down of communities to lessen the potential community-spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) as people are confined to their homes, and
- WHEREAS,** this has been occurring since March 27, 2020 when the Tribal President issued a Reservation-Wide Curfew that restricted members from moving freely from their homes and only for emergency purposes, and with no foreseeable end to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, it is necessary to increase the capacity to collect and dispose of waste being generated, and
- WHEREAS,** in order to provide for the increased, necessary and essential sanitation services during the State of Emergency related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), **the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Coronavirus COVID-19 Federal Relief Funds Oversight Committee recommends the Rosebud**


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves the selection and purchase of two (2) Sanitation Trucks and equipment for \$369,894.00, and one (1) Hook/Roll-off Truck and equipment for \$180,340.00 for a grand total of \$550,234.00 from Sanitation Products Inc., Sioux Falls, South Dakota on a sole source basis due to immediate availability and urgent need to provide increased public health and sanitation services due to the State of Emergency related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe or his authorized designee is authorized and directed to sign and execute the purchase agreement for two (2) Sanitation Trucks and one (1) Hook/Roll-Off Truck and equipment from Sanitation Products Inc., Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

- WHEREAS,** RST Procurement Policies and Procedures requires a bidding process and approval by the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council for the acquisition of goods and services in the amount of \$10,000.00 and over; and
