- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
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- WHEREAS, the funds available in the CTGP contract are identified under line item 207-SRD17-TOR I-207FY 16 Trespass Ordinance in the amount of \$85,000.00; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribe approves a Memorandum of Agreement between Tribal Court and Sicangu Resource Development for the expenditure of these identified contract funds toward the revision of; Title Two, Protection of Adults, Title Four, Civil Procedure Rules Title Five, Crimes, Title Seven, Criminal Procedures, Title Eight, Remedies, Title Nine, Administrative Provisions of Tribal Court and drafting of policies, procedures, court rules, and any other ordinances that will support the approved changes to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Law and Order Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court will serve as the cognizant program in the MOA for all invoices to pass through and following the 638 process for payment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this MOA will end on completion of work and final report or expire on September 30, 2021 whichever date comes first; and

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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBAL COURT AND CONSOLIDATED TRIBAL GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court and Consolidated Tribal Government Programs is effective <u>December 12, 2019</u> through <u>September 21, 2021</u>.

Section 1: Purpose and Authority

- 1.1 This MOA will establish roles and responsibilities of each of the parties in connection with the collaborative effort toward providing continued services in revising and updating Ordinances of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's Law and Order Code; specifically Title Two, Protection of Adults, Title Four, Civil Procedure Rules Title Five, Crimes, Title Seven, Criminal Procedures, Title Eight, Remedies, Title Nine, Administrative Provisions of Tribal Court and drafting of policy, procedure, court rules, and any other ordinances that will support the approved changes to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Law and Order Code.
- 1.2 The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has been operating contract number A16AV00001, Consolidated Tribal Government Programs (CTGP). The Tribe has a Tribal Government component of the aforementioned contract.
- 1.3 The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has also been operating contract number A19AV00008, Tribal Court Services, which contains a temporary Legislative Analyst/Coordinator position tasked with revising specified titles of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Law and Order Code.
- 1.4 Currently, there are available funds for the Tribal Court in the amount of \$85,000.00 in the CTGP contract that may be re-scoped and re-budgeted for use by the Tribal Court and utilized toward the activities identified in section 1.1 of this section.
- 1.5 The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has made a decision to incorporate this MOA into the current CTGP and Tribal Court Services, P.L. 93-638 contracts. This decision is supported by an authorizing resolution, number 2020-____, from the Tribal Council.

Section 2: Responsibilities of the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court

- 2.1 The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court will submit a statement of work, budget, budget justification, and authorizing resolution to Tribal Finance and the local Bureau of Indian Affairs office.
- 2.2 The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court will process invoices through the established processes for "638" funds, including any processes for payroll.
