

ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
Resolution No. 2020-100

- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws Article IV Sections 1 (l), (m), (p) and (q), and
- WHEREAS**, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal President has declared on March 13, 2020 that a State of Emergency exists within the Rosebud Sioux Tribe as it relates to the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Said declaration was made after the World Health Organization (WHO) declared on March 11, 2020 that COVID-19 was a global pandemic; and
- WHEREAS**, There still exists a global pandemic and that as of April 21, 2020, the COVID-19 has infected over 800,000 people nationally resulting in over 40,000 deaths nationally; and
- WHEREAS**, To date, there has been only one confirmed case within Todd County, SD and that person has recovered; and
- WHEREAS**, Mitigation efforts undertaken by President Bordeaux and this Tribal Council appear to be working and that work needs to continue to prevent the spread of the virus; and
- WHEREAS**, Rosebud Sioux Tribe Law Enforcement notes that since President Bordeaux ordered the 10 pm curfew, that a significant number of arrests and calls for service have involved alcohol; and
- WHEREAS**, the safety of the community during the global pandemic depends on actions by this council and that banning the transport of alcoholic beverages is consistent with that purpose; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council does hereby temporarily ban the transport of alcoholic beverages within the reservation and that anyone that has alcohol in a vehicle that they are in control of will be issued a civil fine of \$250 in addition to any criminal charges that may/may not result from a lawfully executed stop based on probable cause; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this ban shall expire when the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe has completed lifted the State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 or if the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council rescinds this ban prior to that time; and
- BE IT ALSO RESOLVED**, that the RST Office of the Secretary shall distribute a copy of this resolution to the Chief of Police, the Chief Judge of the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court, to the RST Prosecutor's Office, the RST Public Defender's Office, and wherever else required by law.
