

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
RESOLUTION NO. 2020-81**

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws Article IV Sections 1 (k), and (m), and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council has enacted RST Ordinance No. 80-02, creating and establishing the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's Governmental Affairs Committee, authorizing the RST Governmental Affairs Committee to review and recommend all proposed legislation; and

WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Governmental Affairs Committee has recommended the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council authorize and direct legal counsel for the Tribe to file a motion to compel Cottonwood Knoll, LLC, to perform its obligations under the Land Lease for confined animal facility, or hog farm site in federal district court, and also to direct the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe to authorize and direct any and all tribal employees, directors and programs to assist the Tribe's efforts to compel performance of Cottonwood Knoll LLC's legal obligations under the Hog Farm Land Lease; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves the recommendation to authorize his office to pursue an order compelling Cottonwood Knoll LLC to comply with and to perform any and all legal obligations under the Land Lease and any other necessary litigation in federal court against Cottonwood Knoll LLC; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is authorized to direct any and all tribal employees, directors and programs to assist the Tribe's efforts to compel Cottonwood Knoll, LLC to perform its legal obligations under the Land Lease and to sign and execute any and all necessary documents on behalf of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe.
